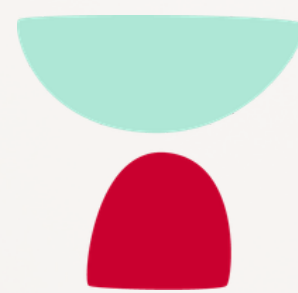

When non-fatal strangulation (NFS) occurs, the first response matters.

For victim-survivors, early recognition, skilled care, clear documentation and coordinated referral can change the pathway to safety, health and justice. This landmark Tasmanian forum brings together leading experts, lived-experience advocates and specialist family and sexual violence practitioners for a practical, sector-wide conversation about how we identify and respond to non-fatal strangulation.

If you work in general practice, ambulance, police, accident and emergency, family violence or sexual violence response, this forum is designed for you.

WHY YOU SHOULD ATTEND

Effective early response is crucial when non-fatal strangulation is suspected or disclosed. An effective early response, grounded in prompt recognition, skilled care, clear documentation and coordinated referral, can make a meaningful difference to a victim-survivor's safety, health and access to justice. **Note: General Practitioners can self record CDP and a statement of attainment will be provided.**
